Named for Fred and Betty Travis, long-time educators in Chautauqua County, Kansas. At least one non-renewable scholarship will be awarded to a worthy Sedan High school graduate planning to attend college. This scholarship is open to all SHS graduates however priority for this scholarship award will be given to students entering the field of education. Students may reapply for this award on a year-to-year basis.

- Select one question and submit a typed, 1-2 page, double-spaced essay response:
 1. Describe a significant challenge, opportunity or setback in your life and the impact it has had on your decision to enter your chosen field; or,
 2. Reflect upon your personal strengths and leadership abilities and describe how you feel you will be able to give back to your community as you become part of the adult community.

The recipient of the Travis Scholarship will be notified by letter by May 31, 2022.

All application materials must be submitted to the Sedan High School Counselor's office by 4:00 pm on Friday, March 11th, 2022. Incomplete applications may be disqualified.
