

SEDAN UNITED METHODIST CHURCH FAIR STAND SCHOLARSHIP

The Sedan United Methodist Church Fair Stand Committee offers at least one scholarship for Sedan High School graduates who are members of and/or active participants in the Sedan United Methodist Church. Awards are based on the following criteria:

1. Fair Stand work:
 - a. During high school – a minimum of 20 hours (cumulative over 4 school years).
 - b. During college – a minimum of 4 hours each year.
 - c. At least half of the worked hours must be during the peak hours of 11 a.m. to 1 a.m. and 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.
 - d. A sign in/out sheet is provided at the fair stand to keep track of worked hours.
 - e. First choice is given to attending Church members who have worked in the Fair stand or have had other family members working in the stand on their behalf because of a summer job which prevents them from working in the fair stand.
 1. Regular church attendance and involvement.
 2. Academic achievement.
 3. College: minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 in at least 12 credit hours per semester.
 - f. Participation in school/community activities.

The scholarships are open to graduating seniors and high school graduates already or planning to attend accredited colleges or vocational schools. This scholarship will be renewable for up to four years of college education. As long as requirements are met.

Scholarship recipient(s) will be selected each year at the conclusion of the county fair. The number and amount of awards will be determined each year by the Fair Stand committee. Award payment will be one-half of the amount each semester UPON PROOF OF ENROLLMENT AND PROOF OF MINIMUM ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS (transcript or grade card). The United Methodist Church Fair Scholarship will be administered by the UMC Fair Stand Committee.

Persons interested in receiving the scholarships must submit a letter of application along with a resume. The application/resume must include a statement of educational plans and goals, schools activities and leadership position, community and church related activities (including fair stand work), statement of financial need, current G.P.A., class rank and a Statement explaining why you should be considered for this scholarship.

Application letter and resume must be submitted by April 21 or will not be accepted.
Applicant letter and resume must be submitted by Jan. 15 or will not be accepted.
