Superintendent Report

Nathan Hinrichs, Supt., reviewed cash/budget balances, gave a transportation update, mentioning the district is scheduled to buy a new activities bus this summer. Discussed facility's needs and plans to meet with John Heckman and Nabholtz Construction to evaluate the needs for expanding the elementary school. Talked about current vacancies and would like to hire temporary help for transportation and custodial staff during the summer months. Gave an update on teacher's negotiations. Advised the school board members about the intruder drill that was held in conjunction with the local law enforcement and emergency management on Tuesday, March 6th, while each board member talked extensively on their views, opinions and concerns regarding school safety.

Nathan Hinrichs, Supt., mentioned to the board that we still have not received any applications for the vacant position for school board member which was created by the resignation of Michael Clark (Seat #3, Position #3) on October 10, 2016, indicating that there is no deadline for the vacancy and the seat is not up for re-election until November 2019.
